3. **Obtain current teacher signatures** for any circled course with a ■ to indicate you have met the prerequisites for the course. AP, AVID, OJT, and Baker Buddies courses also require a completed application for each course in order to register. (DE must already be a DE student).
4. At the bottom of this sheet, **list four (4) alternate** course selections. List in order of preference.
5. Obtain **parent** and student **signatures**.
6. **Bring** completed Course Selection Sheet, Academic History and AP/OJT/Baker Buddies application (if applicable) with you **to your assigned registration time**. Only students with their completed Course Selection Sheet will be permitted to register at their assigned time. All other students will need to turn in sheets to Students Services by March 27th (otherwise courses will be selected for you). Be aware that many courses fill early, so students who register at their regularly scheduled time have the best chance of receiving their top choices.
