

Research Class Syllabus for Edgenuity (E2020) Courses

About Edgenuity:

Edgenuity (<http://edgenuity.leeschools.net>) is an online program where students complete a class for credit recovery or initial credit that is required for graduation. Students can work from home to do all activities except for Topic Tests and Cumulative Exams, which require teacher supervision. A teacher facilitates the program and monitors student progress.

Materials Required: (in class daily)

- Composition marble notebook (optional)
- Chromebooks
- Headphones

Grading Procedures:

Student's grades for classes they are working on are generated by the Edgenuity program and will not be entered in the Focus system for interims, and quarter grades. Students are expected to complete at least one course in a semester, and the grade for that course will be reflected on their report card. Parents can monitor students' progress by using the Edgenuity Family Portal (see details below).

Student Progress:

Students will conference with their e2020 teacher bi-monthly to discuss their progress in order to keep on target to complete their course. A start date and a targeted end date will be entered for the course depending on when the class is started. For students beginning a new course, the start date will be the first day of their class and the target date will be the last day for the semester. Start dates and target dates will be adjusted for students who have a class partially completed or who start a class later in the semester. If students take advantage of working on their class at home on their Chromebook, then it is possible to complete a class in less time. Pinnacle will not reflect student progress, parents view progress through the Edgenuity Family Portal.

Every student is expected to complete at least one class per semester. Failure to complete a class may result in losing the privilege of having a block in the school day to work on an Edgenuity course, therefore, the student would have to work on the class out of school and come in after school to take tests.

Family Portal:

The Family Portal is a site which allows parents access to current information about their student's progress and performance. Parents will be able to see a range of information such as how much time the student has spent working on their courses, what their grades are, and if they are on track to finish their courses on time. Parents must provide an email address to receive weekly progress reports and gain access to the Portal.

The Family Portal feature must be enabled by your student's teacher/admin. An access code will be provided to you by the teacher/admin to use in the registration process once you have submitted your email address to the teacher. Knowing how your child is performing in their course is something important to all parents and guardians; therefore along with the activation code you will receive information on how to understand your child's progress report. Information on use and access to the Family Portal will be sent home the first week of school and can be accessed on the Edgenuity page of the school website. <http://edgenuity.leeschools.net/>

After school Edgenuity:

Edgenuity will be available after school three days per week for students who need to take a test or exam. A schedule will be provided to students after the first couple of weeks of school. Students are expected to work on their Edgenuity class at home on their Chromebook to speed their progress.

Classroom Expectations:

- Students are expected to be on time to class and are expected to use the restroom and drinking fountain prior to coming to class.
- Students are expected to track their progress and be engaged continuously by viewing and listening to online instruction, complete all activities and take notes as needed.
- This is an independent study class, therefore silence is required.
- Respectful reciprocations to teacher and peers are expected at all times.
- Food in the classroom is not permitted; only bottles of water are permitted in class.
- There is a no pass policy for this class. Any special needs should be discussed with the teacher.
- Students are expected to leave phones and other electronic devices off and/or parked with the teacher. If phone is in site or in use it will be turned into student services and returned at the end of the day.

Consequences for Inappropriate Use of Internet

1st Offense - parent letter sent home (student account disabled until the letter is returned signed by the parent)

2nd offense: Referral and 2 days OSS as outlined in the District’s Code of Conduct.
