

## ***Senior Presentations Checklist***

**Audience:** Panel of career pathway community members

**Content for Persuasive Presentation includes:**

- ◆ Personal Statement/Personal Career Plan
- ◆ Teamwork examples
- ◆ Tangible Product that demonstrates quality work and skills
- ◆ From the Best Works folder, highlight at least two other sections of the portfolio as evidence of both academic (EALRs) and employability skills (SCANS)
- ◆ Accomplishments and Activities highlights
- ◆ Examples of Critical Thinking, Problem Solving, and Use of Inquiry
- ◆ Post-high School Plan/Financial Plan highlights
- ◆ Service Learning (detail how it addresses community need, show ways it is connected to learning and career, how many unpaid hours of experience or work experience related to the career plan)
- ◆ Reflection on confidence in preparation for future success

**Presentation Performance Evaluation:**

- ◆ Presentation convinces audience the student is prepared with academic and employability skills required for the identified post high school plan
  - Visual aids to enhance or support the presentation
- ◆ Content is well organized
- ◆ Presentation meets the time limits specified
- ◆ Meets other good presentation standards as established by the school/instructor
